THOUSANDS OF MEMBERS HOLD HUGE RALLY FOR A GREAT CONTRACT!

WE CREATED A SEA OF PURPLE AT THE CAPITOL

One day after the state flat-out rejected our pay proposals, thousands of members converged on the state Capitol on June 8 and created a sea of purple on the Capitol lawn. Together, we delivered a message loud and clear: This is not the end. We are united in our fight for a great contract and we will continue to fight until we win!

This was our moment to come together and share what we've done so far and what is still ahead.

On June 7, the state completely disregarded the work that we do and services we provide to California by rejecting our pay raise proposals without offering any alternate solution.


