Actions are opportunities to show support for our bargaining team and strengthen the Organizing Committee in your workplace. Every Wednesday you can:

LOW

Low level actions are designed to increase visibility in support of the bargaining team. These are opportunities to active our members and strengthen the Organizing Committee in your workplace to show the State our support for the bargaining team. Some examples include:

- Post photos to social media
- Coordinate solidarity breaks
- Purple up
- Button up
- Sticker up
- Chalk the public sidewalks
- Showcase contract campaign slogans and themes

MEDIUM

Medium level actions are designed to increase the pressure on the State during key moments at bargaining. These actions must be planned in coordination with your organizer and approved by Local 1000 to ensure your action is legally compliant.

- Coordinate themed solidarity breaks
- Post photos to social media and tag targeted people
- Record & post 30-60 second videos about bargaining themes
- Coordinate calls to management
- Coordinate emails to management
- Coordinate visits to management
- Solidarity petitions/pledges

HIGH

High level actions create leverage for priority issues during key moments in bargaining and are to be used when absolutely necessary. You must work closely with an organizer or key leaders in your area to organize high level actions that are approved and supported by our Union. These high level actions are demonstrations to show the State how much we care about an issue and must be conducted in coordination with our Union to ensure they are legally compliant. Individual or local actions of this nature that are not approved may NOT be conducted.
