What is a Pre-Apprenticeship?

Apprenticeship USA defines Pre- Apprenticeship as:

"Pre-apprenticeship is a program or set of strategies designed to prepare individuals for entry into Registered

Apprenticeship Programs (RAP) or other job opportunities. Pre-apprenticeships may last from a few weeks to a few
months and may or may not include wages or stipend. Pre-apprenticeship programs have varied program elements;

however, at the core, places an individual on a pathway to employability through a RAP."

What is the LVN to RN Pre-Apprenticeship Program?

The program aims to assist current CCHCS Licensed Vocational Nurses to successfully complete remaining science courses required to apply for their targeted Licensed Vocational Nurse (LVN) to Registered Nurse (RN) Apprenticeship Program at either RCC or SJDC.

Requirements for Eligibility of Consideration:

- Have a current permanent, full time civil service status appointment in an LVN classification working for CCHCS and have passed the probationary period.
- Work for a participating institution at CCHCS (see next slide for a list of participating institutions)
- Be in good standing, have positive attendance, and no Adverse Action within one (1) year of the final filing date (May 31, 2023)
- Have completed a minimum of nine (9) units prerequisite coursework units for their targeted LVN to RN Apprenticeship Program at RCC or SJDC

Pre-Apprenticeship Benefits

- Tuition fees for pre-apprenticeship coursework will be reimbursed
- Flexible work schedule that allows Pre-Apprentices to meet class schedules
- Support from the Joint Apprenticeship Committee (JAC)
 - Including individual support
 - Early intervention from CCHCS, SEIU Local 1000's Coordinators and each respective college's Student Success Center
- Priority acceptance into their targeted apprenticeship program (once apprenticeship program criteria are met)

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Best Practices for Pre-Apprentices/Students


- Practice self-direction! This program requires you to demonstrate self-initiative and follow through.
- Communicate!! Reach out with any questions or issues you have as soon as possible
- Be responsive and check all emails (including work and personal emails)
- Develop relationships with your fellow students you both will benefit!
- Do not procrastinate class will move quickly!
- Be prepared to make sacrifices
- Remember that every day is an interview



Basic Steps: Pre-Apprenticeship Application Process

- 1. Apply as a student to the Fall 2023 Semester at either SCC or SJDC. Do this as soon as possible in order to obtain the earliest available enrollment appointment. Classes fill up quickly.
- 2. Enroll in one of the Pre-Apprenticeship Approved Courses during your college enrollment process.
- 3. Complete the Pre-Apprenticeship Application and submit it by May 31, 2023.

Important Dates for Pre-Apprenticeship Application



Note: To be eligible to apply for the Pre-Apprenticeship Program, interested applicants must submit an application to CCHCS and independently register for a pre-apprenticeship course for Fall 2023 with RCC.

Pre-Apprenticeship Application Submission Process

Subsequent to registering for an approved preapprenticeship course, applicants must submit a complete LVN to RN Pre-Apprenticeship Application to the JAC for review along with the following documents:

- Documentation of registration in the pre-apprenticeship course
- Copies of unofficial transcripts

If submitting electronically, email applications to:

If submitting by mail, applications can be sent to:

Applicants can expect to receive notice of their application status within six to eight weeks of the application deadline.
