Language Specific Programming for Asian Pacific Islanders (API)

Journey Out offers a specialized program through the Asian Pacific Aids Intervention Team (APAIT) in Koreatown. This collaboration offers a culturally relevant program for Asian Pacific Islanders in a variety of languages. Sessions cover immigration, sex trafficking in the API community, and other culturally relevant needs of API sex trafficking victims.

Mentoring

Journey Out survivors provide one-on-one mentorship to anyone involved in the Life of commercial sexual exploitation and sex trafficking. They offer advice and hope as a living example that it is possible to get out, stay out and pursue their true calling.

Clinical Counseling

In addition to group therapy, Journey Out offers clinical counseling with licensed therapists free of charge. Recognizing the necessity of addressing psychological trauma, Journey Out is committed to providing every avenue for healing possible.

We empower victims of commercial sexual exploitation and sex trafficking to leave a life of abuse and violence, overcome their fears, and achieve their goals



Drop-In Center Programs

We offer workshops on topics including Getting Out of the Life, Addiction and Recovery and Self Worth. Workshops are for women, men and transgender individuals. Survivors of the commercial sex industry facilitate our workshops; many have graduated from the program.

Diversion Program

As a court-approved alternative to prosecution, the diversion program allows for a prostitution-related offense to be dismissed upon completion of the program. The goal of the programming is to aid individuals out of sex trafficking and commercial exploitation by addressing the unique and difficult barriers that they face.

Crisis Response Team

The Crisis Response Team provides emergency intervention, case management, survivor mentorship and wrap-around services during and after encounters with law enforcement. This includes assistance with housing, clothing, food and other basic necessities.
