ELECTION ANNOUNCEMENT AND TIMELINES FOR LOCAL 1000 OFFICERS AND DELEGATES

- Jan. 4 **Nomination period begins.** First day for acceptance of nomination forms and optional 100-word candidate statements. Nomination forms will be made available at: seiu1000.org/leadership-elections. Materials will be accepted by mail - addressed to Election Staff, c/o SEIU Local 1000, 1808 14th Street, Sacramento, CA 95811; via fax at 916-554-1295 or via email: local1000elections@seiu1000.org
- Feb. 8 **Nomination period ends.** Completed nomination forms and optional 100-word candidate statements must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. deadline.
- Feb. 12 **Final Day to Withdraw Candidacy.** All withdrawal submissions must be submitted no later than 5:00 p.m., via email at local1000elections@seiu1000.org, by fax to 916-554-1295, or by mail addressed to Election Staff, c/o SEIU Local 1000, 1808 14th Street, Sacramento, CA 95811.
- Feb. 19 Uncontested Candidates will be notified.
- April 19 **Balloting period begins.** Ballots mailed to members.
- May 3 First day to request replacement ballots — call the Member Resource Center at 866.471.SEIU (7348).
- May 7 Last day to request replacement ballots 5:00 p.m. deadline.
- May 20 **Balloting period ends.** 5:00 p.m. deadline for receipt of ballots. Ballots must be received inside of the signed and sealed pre-addressed, postage paid return envelope that is provided. Ballots must be returned to 1100 Melody Lane, Roseville, CA 95678. Ballot opening and sorting begins at 1:00 p.m. Observers welcome.
- May 21 Ballot opening and sorting continues - beginning at 9:00 a.m. Observers welcome.
- May 24 & 25 Ballot counting begins — 9:00 a.m., 1100 Melody Lane, Roseville, CA 95678. Observers welcome.
- May 28 Official results posted to seiu1000.org/leadership-elections by 5:00 p.m. Elected candidates will be notified.
- June 1-10 **Protest period.** All protests must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on June 10, 2021. Protests should be addressed to: Attn: Yvonne R. Walker, President, SEIU Local 1000, 1808 14th Street, Sacramento, CA 95811
- June 25 Protest Committee findings completed. Parties notified.
