SEIU LOCAL
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CALIFORNIA'S STATE BUDGET HAS INCREASED BY **BILLIONS** OVER THE LAST 3 YEARS

- Annual budget revenues continue to out-pace projections while the state has amassed the highest level of reserves in the last 30 years – around \$35B
- A new Temporary Surplus fund is getting a \$6.4 billion deposit
- The Rainy-Day fund is growing from \$11.5 to \$15 billion



\$1.3B REVENUE **INCREASE** BETWEEN THE MAY REVISE AND THE FINAL BUDGET

- \$900M of this was left unallocated while we've sacrificed \$762M from our paychecks over the last and current fiscal year

THE STATE TURNS TO **COSTLY, PRIVATE** **VENDORS** TO DO CIVIL SERVICE WORK

- \$100s of millions currently spent on outsourcing our jobs in Custodial and Health Care services
 - Department of State Hospitals: \$180 million in health care contracts
 - CDCR: Over \$50 million in Custodial contracts and over \$100 million in health care contracts
